### Final Election Results

The unofficial election results regarding the proposed Inclusion (merger) of CPNMD's water and wastewater utilities with those of the Parker Water & Sanitation District (Ballot Question 6A) are:

Votes **FOR** Inclusion: 2,709 (95.76%)

Votes **AGAINST** Inclusion: 120 (4.24%)

**Next Steps:** We sincerely thank all the people of Castle Pines west of I-25 for their patience, confidence, and trust these last three years. With an eye on **Monday, January 3, 2022**, we will work the next eight months to seamlessly transition our community's water and wastewater utilities to Parker Water & Sanitation District's jurisdiction, and thereby enable the people of our community to become full beneficiaries of PWSD's 75% renewable water plan and Rueter-Hess Reservoir. Separately, with renewed emphasis on CPNMD's core objectives three and four ([cpnmd.org/about](http://cpnmd.org/about)), we will also use those eight months to thoroughly evaluate the potential future of CPNMD's remaining service and stewardship responsibilities — namely, the community's storm drainage system, 352 acres of open space, 14 miles of trails, and three parks, including Coyote Ridge Park, Daniels Park and Retreat Park. Doing so reflects our commitment to ensure the people of Castle Pines west of I-25 continue to enjoy clean, safe, well-maintained outdoor amenities and a reliable storm drainage system, **in perpetuity, and at the lowest possible cost.** Once again, we respectfully ask for your continued patience, confidence, and trust.
