A BIT OF GOOD NEWS!

On the condition of adherence to minimum social distancing of six feet and in groups of no more than ten people, it is with the blessing of the Douglas County Sheriff's Department — at least until the Tri-County Health Department and/or the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment (CDPHE) direct otherwise — that our skatepark, basketball courts, and picnic facilities in Coyote Ridge, The Retreat, and Daniels Gate parks are hereby open.

CAUTION: Per Colorado's <u>Third Amended Public Health Order 20-28 Safer At Home</u>, CPNMD playgrounds remain closed until further notice. Consequently, we respectfully ask residents to observe the **PLAYGROUND TEMPORARILY CLOSED** signage at each CPNMD playground.
