New rate and fee structures take effect January 1, 2014

Following two consecutive years of adopting no drinking water, wastewater, or storm water rate or fee increases in 2011 and 2012, the District Board tasked StepWise Utility Advisors (now MWH Global) with completing a comprehensive rate study. Last year, based on MWH Global's recommendations, the District Board adopted a cost-of-service model that will enable the District to responsibly and transparently cover expenses, but that will likely require annual rate and fee adjustments. Consistent with transitioning to that cost-of-service model, the District implemented a bill increase for 2013, as shown below.

- approximately 71% of monthly residential bills will reflect a combined water, wastewater, and storm drainage bill increase of \$6 or less;
- the monthly water bill will increase \$2.76;
- the median monthly wastewater bill will increase \$1.33;
- the median monthly storm drainage bill will increase \$1, for a 3/4" In-District meter; and
- the storm water increase is necessary to repair damage to sto

- ¹ Customer Charge Water on your monthly bill applies to the District's day-to-day water-related operations, including, but not limited to: (a) transporting the District's seasonal renewable water through Centennial Water and Sanitation District's water treatment plant to our District's pump station and water distribution system, (b) maintaining and repairing water infrastructure (e.g., water treatment plant, ten groundwater wells and associated pumps), (c) paying for the electricity required to operate the District's renewable water pump station, groundwater well pumps, booster pumps, and the water treatment plant), (d) adjudicating and monitoring the District's water rights, (e) water quality monitoring and testing, (f) funding the water rebate program, and (g) staff.
- ² Capital Improvement Fee Water on your monthly bill applies to construction and/or acquisition of waterrelated infrastructure including, but not limited to: (a) the ICPP pump station & pipeline, (b) groundwater well replacement, (c) Chatfield Expansion & Reallocation Project, (d) Meadow Island Ditch rights, and (e) future renewable water infrastructure.
- ³ **Customer Charge Wastewater** on your monthly bill applies to the District's day-to-day wastewater-related operations, including, but not limited to lift station and sewage treatment operations.
- ⁴ **Storm Drainage Charge** on your monthly bill applies to the District's storm water operations and infrastructure maintenance and repair.
