Water Rate Study






Financial Planning Drivers

- Debt service for:
 - CPNMD's participation in Chatfield Reservoir Expansion & Reallocation Project
 - CPNMD's 1,500 acre-feet of raw-water storage in Rueter-Hess Reservoir
 - Meet the minimum debt-service-coverage requirement
- Conservative assumption of annual inflation
- Review Capital Maintenance & Renewable Water Investment revenues.



Projected Five-Year Operating Financial Plan


We recommend a rate-revenue increases of **3.0%** in 2020 and 2021, and, barring unforeseen circumstances, **2.5%** each year thereafter through 2024.




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Proposed 2020 Monthly Fixed Water Charges


We recommend that both the Capital Maintenance Charge and the Renewable Water Investment Charge remain unchanged.




Proposed Water Usage Charges, per tier, for the Residential Customer Classification








Proposed Water Usage Charges, per Tier, for the Commercial Customer Classification


Financial Planning Drivers

- Debt service for:
 - Plum Creek Water Reclamation Authority (PCWRA)
 - Meet minimum debt-service-coverage requirement
- Conservative assumption of annual inflation
- Anticipation of, and capital for, infrastructure repairs and replacements



Projected Five-Year Financial Plan

We recommend a rate-revenue increase of **4.0%** in 2020, and barring unforeseen circumstances, **3.0%** from 2021 through 2024.



Proposed 2020 Fixed Monthly Wastewater Service Charge for Sewer Service






Proposed 2020 Wastewater Usage Charge for Sewer Service





Proposed 2020 Bill Impacts for Monthly Wastewater Service



If approved, all In-District customers would see a fixed charge increase of \$.54 and a wastewater usage charge increase of \$.26 per 1,000 gallons of winter use.



Proposed 2020 Storm Drainage Charge

We recommend that the Storm Drainage Charge remain unchanged.




Combined Residential Bill Impacts





Proposed 2020 <u>TOTAL</u> Monthly Residential Bill Impacts

If approved, 95% of all residential bills in 2020 would reflect a total cost increase of \$8 or less, while the average residential bill would increase by \$3.76.
